We were fortunate to be able to hold the Fourteenth Annual Winter Beach Ball on March 10th at the Anah Shrine. We are proud to report that we kicked off 2021 with a Calendar fundraiser, which was a huge success and netted \$7,545! 
## Friends of the Auxiliary
