

New CDC mask update – based on your community level COVID-19

Low

- Stay up to date with COVID-19 vaccines
- Get tested if you have symptoms

Medium

- If you are at high risk for severe illness, talk to your healthcare provider about whether you need to wear a mask and take other precautions
- Stay <u>up to date</u> with
 COVID-19 vaccines
- •Get tested if you have symptoms

<u>High</u>

- Wear a <u>mask</u> indoors in public
- Stay <u>up to date</u> with COVID-19 vaccines
- •<u>Get tested</u> if you have symptoms
- Additional precautions may be needed for people <u>at high risk for</u> severe illness

Defining your community as low, medium, or high

COVID-19 by County | CDC

Low

- Indicates the virus is having a limited effect on the healthcare system
- Low levels of severe disease

Medium

- More people with severe disease
- Beginning to see an increase in how much COVID-19 is affecting their healthcare system
- People who may be at increased risk talk to their healthcare providers about taking additional precautions, such as mask-wearing

High

- High level of severe disease
- High potential for a community's healthcare system to become strained
- Everyone wear a mask indoors and in schools
- In addition to the precautions at the low and medium levels

Treatment options – Positive COVID-19

- Recently tested positive for COVID-19? Self-referrals to be screened for treatment options are now open
- For people at high risk of severe illness from COVID-19 <u>early treatment for COVID-19</u>
- COVID-19 home tests are easy to use

COVID-19 Vaccination and Booster Eligibility Updates

Booster dose appointments for Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccines are now available for people 18 and over who meet criteria.

People 5 years or older are currently eligible to schedule a COVID-19 vaccination.

Important:

- Community members under age 18 who would like to be vaccinated, must have a parent or guardian complete and initial the online scheduling form on their behalf.
- In addition to scheduling a vaccine using the online process, patients under 18 are be required to bring a completed consent to treat formsigned by their parent or guardian to their appointment.
- Patients under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian to their vaccination.

- Please print your appointment confirmation and bring it with you. Vaccination candidates will receive an email confirming their vaccination location
