What an incredible start to 2022! We are finally through the worst of winter and will be enjoying the sunshine very soon. The Board of Directors has been hard at work to make this year fun, successful in our pledge and another year to be proud of.

Since our inception almost 130 years ago, our Board of Directors has been

blessed with talented women who are extremely hard working, and a membership that has stepped in when needed, to help ensure our undertakings were successful. Aided by their dedication and invaluable support, we have donated close to \$4 million over the past 130 years. These funds have always benefited the healthcare needs of those in our community, such as supporting the purchase of operating equipment, ECG machines, nursing scholarships, funding towards the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit, the purchase of specialized incubators for neonatal intensive care babies and supporting funding of Cancer Care in Brewer. We are in the second year of our \$125K pledge to purchase Miracle 2, an ambulance transport for the

tiniest babies in our community. I am proud to report that we have successfully fulfilled our first installment of \$25K in 2021 and 2022 is shaping up to be another successful year as well! I am in awe of what we have been able to accomplish and excited at what the future holds.

Despite the challenges of the last two years, the Auxiliary and the Board continue to thrive, innovate our fundraising activities, and come up with new and refreshed ways to fundraise to fulfill our mission. Our incredible work continues with many new events such as restaurant fundraisers, calendar fundraisers, Mother's Day and Father's Day Basket fundraisers, and our biggest event of the year, our virtual Kitchen Tour to take place in November.

From community support with a \$5 basket or calendar donations to \$1,000 small business donations or \$5,000 corporate sponsorships the NL EMMC Auxiliary is well on its way to fulfilling its second of five annual pledge payments of \$25,000 towards the purchase of the new Miracle 2 Ambulance. All of this has been accomplished despite Covid when major events could not be held safely. It has certainly become a miracle for this notfor-profit organization, the community and the NL EMMC Transport Team.

This ambulance will fulfill a dream for many. **Dr. Jay Hagerty, Neonatologist, tells us** —"Miracle 2 represents a state-of the-art mobile newborn intensive care unit (NICU) that will serve as a lifeline for critically ill newborns, throughout Maine requiring transport to NL-EMMC for lifesaving medical and surgical care. "**Ken Roy, RNC, Transport Team Coordinator states,** —" Miracle 2 will be a remarkable improvement for us in the care of our neonatal patients. It will provide the technology, safety, reliability, and the added comfort for the team and infant. Parents are



putting 100% of their trust in the transport team and equipment when transferring their infant across the state. Thank you for all the time and effort you have placed on this vital piece of transport for the infants of Maine."

Fundraising is still very much needed to fulfill our \$125,000 pledge to ensure this "miracle" happens. The NL EMMC Auxiliary is thankful to all who have supported this endeavor.
