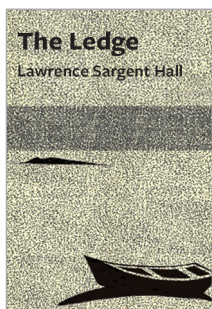

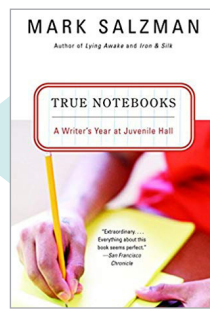
A good book can change everything
