

We continue to adjust our visitor policy as the circumstances surrounding COVID-19 evolve.

Hospital Inpatients

• Medical/Surgical, Inpatient Rehabilitation, and Special Care Units

Inpatients can have **two** visitors (age 16 or older) at any given time between the hours of **8am - 3pm daily**. Visitors must enter through the main entrance and pass the screening process. Visitors must remain masked, maintain six feet physical distance, and stay in the patient's room during the visit. **Visitors can switch out during the day, as long as no more than two people are in the patient room at a time.**

Visitors are only allowed under special circumstances for patients suspected of or confirmed to have COVID-19 or when a patient is undergoing an aerosol generating procedure.

• Women & Children's Unit

One support person is allowed with an expectant mother for the duration of her hospitalization; this person is allowed to leave and return as needed throughout the stay. A second support person is welcome for the labor and recovery period only. For pediatric patients, one parent/guardian can stay with their child at a time, alternating as desired.

Other Hospital Departments

• Emergency Department

One person is allowed to accompany a patient in an ED exam room. The visitor must stay in the patient's room at all times. Visitors are only allowed under special circumstances for patients suspected of or confirmed to have COVID-19 or when a patient is undergoing an aerosol generating procedure.

• Day Surgery

A visitor can accompany a patient and stay in the waiting room during the procedure, as long as they pass the screening and proper safety procedures are followed.

• Ancillary Patient Services (such as Lab, Imaging, Rehabilitation)

No visitors are to accompany patients, with the exception of pediatric and special needs patients, who may each have one support person with them.

Continuing Care, Mars Hill

We welcome visitors for our residents. We recommend that family and friends schedule their visits so we can have staggered time slots that allow us to have safe, physically distanced visiting within the facility. You can schedule a visit by calling **768-4912**.

Outpatient Offices

If a patient needs someone to accompany them due to individual circumstances, accommodations can be made on a case by case basis.

Everyone entering our facilities must wear a mask provided by the hospital and keep it on at all times. You must be screened upon arrival, hand sanitize, and follow physical distance guidelines.
