


# A new promise for parents and families

A spacious, family-focused Birthing Center will provide parents with the best possible environment for welcoming a newborn. **The new Birthing Center will include:** 

- New spacious, comfortable combined labor, delivery, and recovery suites with plenty of space for a support person to stay overnight. The larger layout of the rooms will better accommodate the needs of the care team and technology used to monitor patients.
- Closer proximity to the operating room. If an emergency C-section is needed, the patient can be brought directly to the OR where surgery can be performed without delay.
- A centralized parent and infant monitoring system that closely tracks vital signs, contractions, and other important indicators. The new system will allow monitoring throughout the hospital for more consistent, real-time assessment.
- A quiet, comfortable nursery with the latest in monitoring equipment.
- An infant security system that uses the latest technology to provide the highest level of safety for parents and babies.

At Maine Coast Hospital, obstetrics/ gynecology (OB/GYN) doctors and certified nurse midwives work together to offer parents more choices while providing the highest level of care before, during, and after pregnancy. Our midwifery team, one of the largest in Maine, offers a holistic approach to all aspects of pregnancy and delivery. Our OB/GYN physicians provide the full range of care, including managing high risk pregnancies and performing C-sections when needed. # Comfortable care and privacy Modern patient rooms


When Maine Coast Hospital first opened its doors in 1956, it was common for a hospitalized patient to share a room with another patient. Shared rooms are still common at Maine Coast today. This approach is being phased out in hospitals across the country, and for good reason. When doctors share difficult news with a patient and family, the other patient in the room may hear it, too. Sleep is critical to healing, and it is more difficult to get a good night's sleep with disturbances from roommates, visitors, and the healthcare team. Technology has improved, and patient and family expectations for privacy and comfort have changed.

Today, private rooms are what our patients deserve, and they allow our staff to provide the best possible care. In the more than five decades that they have been in service, our patient rooms have had only minor renovations. With the community's support, we will increase the number of private patient rooms by modernizing existing space.

- A quiet space for patients to rest and heal
- As part of the care team, space for a loved one to stay overnight
- A modern, soothing care setting created with patient and family comfort in mind
- Less congested room layout for the patient, family, and care team
